ADOLESCENT SEXUALITY: TEENS & SEX & WHAT'S HAPPENING IN OUR SCHOOLS

According to the popular press, adolescents today live in a hookup culture filled with gender pressure and risky behavior. This workshop will present a brief overview of recent research on adolescence sexual development including the hookup culture, the impact of social media, transgender identities, and the overall fluidity of sexual identity in adolescents. 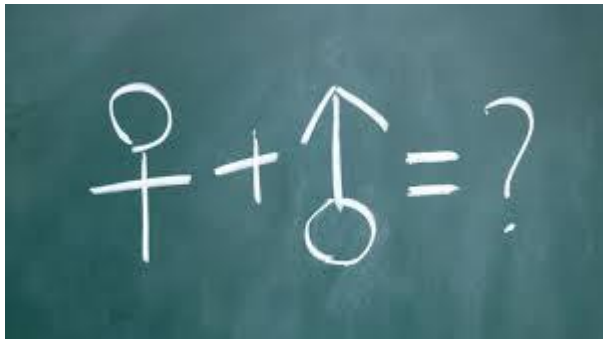
