Through Tele-Play therapy children learn to better communicate, problem solve, discover emotions, develop empathy and interact with the world around them, all while igniting their vivid imaginations! In this workshop, participants will explore tele-play therapy from a deeply creative level and explore how seamlessly play therapy translates on the screen. Attendees will learn how to access developmentally appropriate fun play-based interventions to rewire the brain and create a sense of trust and safety in the child's world.
